Reading Project

- You may use small counting objects (coins, paperclips, cereal) to help
- Check your work using the answer key on the back
- **Bring this packet with your finished math sheets** with you the first day of school: **August 19th.**

Book Project Choices

The project you choose must include these **story elements**:

- ☐ Student's name
- ☐ Title
- ☐ Author
- ☐ One sentence summary of the book
- ☐ One sentence describing the setting of the book (When? Where?)
- ☐ List of main characters in the book. Write one sentence for each character explaining who they are.
- ☐ Main events (What happened at the beginning, middle, and end? What was the biggest problem and how was it solved?)
- ☐ Review (What was your favorite part of the book? Who was your favorite character, and why? How could it be improved, in your opinion?)

Choice 1: Mobile Project

Create illustrated cards for each **story element** and hang them from a hanger or stick. Check them off as you go. Add small objects to represent parts of the story. For example, if the main character loves gum, you could add a stick of gum.

Choice 2: Book-in-a-Bag

Place objects in a bag to represent each **element of the story** and include a card for each object explaining it. Check off the story elements as you go. Decorate the bag to look like the book cover.

Choice 3: Game Project

Create a board game or card game that teaches the class about your book as we play it. Include each of the **story elements** in your game, and check them off as you go. Don't forget to provide a list of rules.

Choice 4: Google Slides

Make a slideshow with one slide per **story element**. Check them off as you go. Add pictures, transitions, and colorful backgrounds. Add extra slides for your favorite parts, good quotes, or new words you found in the book.

I hope you are enjoying a wonderful summer! As we prepare for an exciting new school year, I wanted to share our school supply list for 2026–2027. Having these materials ready on the first day helps students begin the year feeling prepared and confident.

Please send the following items with your child to the ice cream social on **August:16th**

Classroom Supplies

- 1 pack of glue sticks
- 1 pack of dry erase markers
- 1 box of regular markers
- 1 box of tissues
- 2 containers of disinfecting wipes
- 1 box of gallon-size **or** sandwich-size zip-top bags
- 1 pack of sponges without a “scrubber” side

Daily Personal Items
