

Dragon Supply List 2026-2027

Welcome to the 2026-27 school year! The following supplies will be needed at the start of your child's school year.

Classroom supplies:

- two boxes of tissues/kleenex (no scents or lotions)
- two containers of disinfectant wipes (Lysol, Clorox, etc.)
- one package of gallon size baggies (with zip or seal closure)
- one package sponges (without a "scrubber" side)

*Please allow your child to help pick out their favorite **two Art items** to share with their classmates!*

- **2 Art items:** Stickers, feathers, beads, glitter, chalk, play sand, Elmer's glue, pinecones, glue sticks, pom-pom, yarn, ribbon, stamps, ink pad, dot markers, or sequins.

Personal items to be left in child's classroom all year:

****Please LABEL ALL items****

- 4 pairs of socks
- 2 short sleeve shirts and 2 long sleeve shirts
- 2 shorts and 2 pants
- outerwear(*to keep at school*)
 - sun hat (*personal preference*), winter hat, and 2 pair of mittens
- 1 pair of "indoor shoes" that support their independence (*no laces*)
- 1 sleeve of diapers (replenished as needed)
- package of wipes (replenished as needed)
- diaper cream (*with completed medical form*)
- sunscreen (*with completed medical form*)

Items to bring the first day of each week:

****Please LABEL ALL items****

- a toddler nap mat (rolled napping mat w/ blanket and pillow attached)

Bedding items will be returned home for washing at the end of each week.

Items to bring each day (*and fit in child's backpack*):

- 1 plastic folder with Child's name clearly labeled
- 1 water bottle with child's name clearly labeled
- ***Nut Free Lunch*** in a child accessible bag and container (your child can open themselves) *Include an ice pack to keep cool foods cool or thermos for hot foods as a refrigerator or microwave are not available in the classroom. No snacks needed* "Community Snack" will be provided by different toddler families each week - more information to follow

Each day your child should arrive in:

- **Weather appropriate play clothes** that could get messy as students will be enjoying an immersive learning experience. Please be mindful of your child's ability and clothing should be appropriate for supporting independence with self-care in dressing.
- **Outer footwear "outside shoes"** needs to be weather appropriate and support self-care (*no laces*)
