

CHILDREN'S HOUSE SUPPLY LIST

ALL CHILDREN'S HOUSE STUDENTS

Full Size Backpack

- A full-size folder and a lunch box should fit inside
- Easy for student to open and close
- Nothing with wheels
- Has a pocket for refillable water bottle. Water fountains will not be available this year.

Full Size Folder with pockets

- Plastic ones last longer
- Kindergarteners should have a second full size folder with pockets for Kindergarten work

Lunch Box

- Fits inside backpack
- Contains lunch and two snacks (morning and afternoon)
- Two cloth napkins
- Cold pack
- Containers that student can open and close
- Utensils as needed for lunch. **Dishware, microwaves, and silverware will not be available for student use**
- **Food items must be nut free**, including nothing prepared on shared equipment
- No candy or soda
- A box of assorted plasticware. This is in case of missing utensils.

1 plastic storage box for extra clothes.

- Shoe box size if possible
- In the clothing box should be 2 pairs of pants/shorts, 2 pairs underwear, 2-3 pairs socks, 2-3 shirts, 1 sweatshirt/sweater **EVERYTHING MUST BE LABELED**
- Face masks - 3 in case one gets dirty or wet

Face coverings must completely cover the student's nose and mouth.

Cloth face coverings of at least two layers are most effective.

Your child's masks must all be clearly, permanently labeled with their name. Students must arrive at school wearing their masks and have at least one additional mask with them every day. (A minimum of two clean masks each day). Students will not wear masks outside or at nap.

Indoor Shoes

- Everyone changes into indoor footwear upon arrival.
- A pair of well-fitting shoes to leave at school for the year and wear indoors daily
- No tie shoes please
- Whatever students wear to school will be their outside footwear for that day

Plastic Storage (Tool) Box

- This functions as a tool box. Shoe box size
- If possible one with a handle
- Student is able to open and close

Supplies for Tool Box

- Package of #2 pencils
- Box of Crayola markers (fat ones)
- Box of Crayola crayons
- Eraser
- Package of glue sticks
- 24 pack of colored pencils
- Scissors
- Set of watercolors

Classroom Supplies

- Box of quart or gallon Ziploc bags
- Wooden or natural art items - wooden beads, wooden buttons, tree cookies etc. **or** pony beads all different colors
- Ream of copy paper
- Pad of tracing paper
- Ream of white cardstock
- Three pack of Clorox wipes
- 1 pump bottle of unscented clear hand sanitizer (containing at least 60% alcohol and NO METHANOL)

Outdoor Supplies

- Sunscreen
- Hat for sunny days

NAPPERS ONLY

- Nap Bag - please no grocery bags (plastic or paper) LABELED
- Two blankets- one functioning as sheet and the other as a blanket. There won't be any true cot sheets this year because students will need to strip cots every day.
- Lovey that stays at school all week — nothing with batteries, lights or sounds
- Small pillow also stays at school all week
