

Welsh Hills School Supply List Lower Elementary

Welcome to the 2025-26 school year! Please bring the following items to the Ice Cream Social on August 17th or send them with your child on the first day of school, August 20th.

Backpack

- Large enough to hold binders and lunchbox; easy to manage and carry
- No wheels

Snacks and Lunch (every day):

Please label ALL items below with your child's name.

- Water bottle (no single use plastic bottles, please).
- Lunch box containing all lunch and snack items
- A microwave will be available to heat lunches.
- Food items must be NUT FREE, including nothing processed with shared equipment.
- No candy or soda will be permitted.
- Students may pack one item for morning snack. (Please do not send in sugary sweets like cookies, donuts, cupcakes. Appropriate snacks - cut fruit, vegetables, cheese, crackers, yogurt, snack bar.)

Clothing and Shoes:

Indoor Shoes - Students change into indoor footwear upon arrival.

- A pair of well-fitting shoes will stay at school for the year to be worn indoors daily.
- Shoes must be easy for student to put on and take off. If they have laces, student is expected to know how to tie their shoes.
- Whatever students wear to school will be their outside footwear for that day.

Extra Clothing

Please label ALL items below with your child's name.

- 1 plastic storage box (shoe box size preferred) for extra clothes to stay at school all year, replenished as needed
- In the clothing box should be 2 pairs of pants/shorts, 2 pairs underwear, 2-3 pairs socks, 2-3 shirts, 1 sweatshirt/sweater

Personal Care Items Needed:

Please label ALL items below with your child's name.

- 1 container of sunscreen (*with completed medication form)
- 1 container of insect repellent (*with completed medication form)

Classroom Items:

Items below do not need to be labeled with your child's name.

- 2 boxes Kleenex/facial tissues
- 1 package quart sized zip-close plastic bags

Personal Academic Items:

- 2 sturdy, plastic pocket folders (any color)

Additional supplies may be required during the school year.
